



Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Pyropel, Inc. is fully supportive of global industry efforts to ensure responsible manufacturing processes and material sourcing.

Based on the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act passed in July 2010, this act requires companies to report the use of “Conflict Minerals” in their products. “Conflict Minerals” are identified as gold, tantalum, tungsten and tin originating in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or its specified adjoining countries.

As a privately held corporation, Pyropel, Inc. is not subject to the Conflict Minerals reporting requirements. However, as a supplier to publicly traded companies, we are committed to helping our customers comply with their reporting requirements.

Pyropel, Inc. does not use any Conflict Minerals sourced from listed DRC countries in our products. Should we find any information that alters this condition, Pyropel, Inc. will provide updated information.
